F1000's expert Faculty of 10,000 members will then view these submissions to identify those they wish to select for positive evaluation in the award winning F1000 service.

If the abstract of your work will be accepted, to deposit your poster, simply go to <http://f1000.com/posters/depositor> and upload your file and maximize the value of your conference presentations.

Submission instructions

Authors are invited to submit abstracts (in English; in .pdf) on original and previously unpublished work (signed self-certification has be attached in .pdf).

The abstracts and the self-certification has to be sent by email to congress08@ceimars.it,

If accepted, the poster has to be uploaded (in .pdf format) here: <http://f1000.com/posters/depositor>.

Font is your choice; we suggest you a good balance between text and images, and a size so that there is guarantee of easy reading

The final printed poster has to be given in the moment of registration: the 7th of December.

It has to be height of 120 cm, and width of 80 cm.

The setting of it must follow a normal scientific article (introduction, argument, results, conclusion and bibliography).

Don't forget, please, to insert: name of the main Author, surname, address, contacts (phone number and skype-number), kind of specialization, Institution(s) (co)shared for realizing the proposed work, and title of the poster(s).

Authors are invited to sent a signed declaration (in .pdf) attesting the non-conflict of interest (in English and in Italian). Formatting should be using MS-Word style files (or similar).

Double submission policy: Parallel submission to other meetings or publications are not possible.

The Author can present up to 2 posters.

At least, one of the Authors of any accepted poster has to be present and registered to the Convention, and, in case of double acceptance by the Scientific Committee, two authors have to register.

The posters will be permanently exposed during the Convention, but the authors have to assure their presence in the specific session of the 8th December, in order to clarify any possible question by the participants.

Nobody will can have refund or payment.

The workshop posters – if accepted – automatically will be part of the PAMEC proceedings, and published on the web site of F1000 before and after the conference.

(All the specific info will be sent you when the poster has been accepted).
