The (max 16 lines) papers have to be sent only by the format below

- Don't forget, please, to insert: Name, surname, address, contacts (phone number and skype-number), kind of specialization, Institution(s) (co)shared for realizing the proposed work, and the title of the paper.

Authors have to sent a signed declaration (in English and Italian) attesting that non-conflict of interest is present.



Formatting should be using MS-Word style files (or similar).

Double submission policy: Parallel submission to other meetings or publications are not possible.

Authors of accepted papers have to present their research during the workshop. Maximum time for lecturing will be: 20 minutes.

Workshop papers will be part of the PAMEC proceedings and published on the web site of CEIMARS before the conference. The Authors of the best papers can publish them – if Authorized – in the form of a Poster on F1000 website
